

# Introduction to Leadwork

## Course Details



Traditional leadwork forms a key weathering component of traditional roofing in Scotland. Its correct use and detailing are vital to ensuring the robustness and weather-tightness of roofs.

### Who should attend?

This **one day** introduction to leadwork is designed for those specifying or managing the installation/replacement of leadwork. It will be relevant to Architects, Chartered Building Surveyors, Contractors, Heritage professionals and anyone involved in inspecting or specifying leadwork who wish to refresh and improve their understanding of leadwork detailing.

### About the trainer

The Lead Sheet Association (LSA) is the foremost independent technical authority on the design, specification and application of rolled lead sheet in construction. The Association also promotes the use of lead sheet manufactured to BS EN 12588: 2006 on behalf of its members and has been helping the construction industry for over 85 years. Training will be provided by a specialist tutor from the Lead Sheet Association. A certificate of attendance will be issued by Aberdeen City Heritage Trust.

### Training format

The morning session will incorporate an interactive classroom-style session where the tutor will explain the basics of using lead in construction including detailing for flashings, gutters, roofs and dormers. This session will conclude with a practical desk-top exercise to enable participants to put the theory they have learned into practice.

The afternoon session will move into a workshop environment where the traditional leadwork skills of bossing and welding will be demonstrated. Participants will then have the opportunity to try these techniques for themselves.

Participants will receive a copy of the LSA publication 'Rolled Lead Sheet - the complete manual' which is the definitive guide to the use of lead sheet in construction.
